

The Outline of MEO Program

1. The objective of Military Evangelism Observation(MEO) Program

To assist in the establishment and growth of MCFs by inviting potential MCF leaders to observe Korean military evangelism and by teaching them the subjects related to the major activities of MCFs.

2. Period: 1 week including the observation period of the National Salvation Prayer Convention

3. Venue: Osanri Prayer Mountain in the vicinity of Seoul City

4. Host: MSO (Mission Support Organization for AMCF)

5. Participants: Delegations principally from countries without MCF, and secondly from countries with immature MCFs if seriously necessary, thirdly from the country members which participants hope to pay themselves.

(Two delegates from Non-MCF country, 1~2 delegates from weak MCF country)

※ The registration fee is \$20.

7. Major subjects and events

The introduction of the AMCF, ACCTS, MMI and MSO, AMCF Reference Handbook, the establishment and growth of MCFs, Christian leadership, personal evangelism, testimony, Inductive Bible Study, Conversational Prayer, Case Study, the observation of National Salvation Prayer Convention and a joint baptismal ceremony, the introduction to delegation's countries
